Minutes of a Planning Meeting at 7.30pm on Thursday 7 June 2018 in the Village Hall, Buckland Dinham

3430 Present: Councillors Tamsin Aston, Will Phippen, Peter Corbett, Alan King, Viv Street and John Reckless. Clerk Pauline Short

3431 Apologies: None

3432 Code of Conduct - Declarations of Interest: None

3433 Election of Deputy Chair: Cllr Street proposed and Cllr Corbett seconded the proposal that Cllr Phippen should be re-elected as deputy chair. Cllr Phippen was happy to accept the role and all agreed

At this point there was an unminuted open forum for the public to discuss the planning application but, as there were no public present there was no discussion on the topic

3434 Consultation on planning application for erection of a single storey living room extension to the front of Court Corner Bungalow, The Cross: Council discussed the application and agreed to recommend approval

3435 Clerks report and finance (urgent items only):

1. A reply had been received from Somerset County Council agreeing to include the village in the new programme of Speed Indicator Device visits at cost of £400. The plan would be as in previous years except that the councils involved in the programme would need to download the data on line rather than having it delivered individually. It was unknown what this would involve but council agreed to continue with the previous decision to take part in the programme this year and then reconsider for future years after the result is seen
2. Since the last meeting two payments had been made by BACS as agreed previously - £25 to SALC for clerks training and £104.19 to SALC for annual fees to them. Cllr Aston signed the record of both payments
3. As required by the new financial regulations, Cllr Aston was handed a sealed envelope containing the password for the parish council laptop. This should only be opened as defined in the financial regulations
